COMFORT

Dogs are more comfortable in a home than in kennels. At home you can build up their confidence and get them accustomed to a normal home life – and give them a history.

SAVE MONEY FOR THE RESCUE CENTRE

SHORT-TERM OWNERSHIP

HELP A DOG GET ADOPTED

Normally, the rescue centre will still take care of any vet bills while their charge is in your care. Please check with your local rescue centre for their terms and, if you can afford to, consider paying the bills yourself.
